The fire department responded to 37 calls during the month of June 2024. Eight were in the Town of Cowpens, 14 were in the fire district, 13 were in the Spartanburg Mutual Aid District, and two were in the Cherokee County Mutual Aid District.

CC&I Services – Fifteen permits were issued during the month of June 2024. These permits included re-inspection, Commercial Plan Review, residential construction, and electrical.
