TOWN OF COWPENS SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING 5332 N. Main St.

Tuesday, November 12, 2024, 6:00 p.m.

The Town of Cowpens held a special meeting on Tuesday, November 12, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Jarred S. Spencer, Mayor Pro-Tem Erin P. Wofford, Council Members Pam Camp, and Danyelle D. Goode. Absent: Lesa C. Bolin. Mayor Jarred S. Spencer called the meeting to order and held prayer.

Erin P. Wofford made a motion to approve the agenda for November 12, 2024, seconded by Pam Camp, and carried.

Chief Meredith informed the town council that the two 2018 Dodge Chargers need to be replaced. One has knocking lifters and repairs will cost \$2,500 - \$3,000; the second charger has been leaking fuel. The EGR valve was replaced but it is continuing to leak. These vehicles are seven years old and problems continue to arise. Erin P. Wofford made a motion to authorize Chief Meredith to proceed to obtain new vehicles to replace the two Dodge Chargers, seconded by Pam Camp and carried. Financing options will be presented at the regular meeting.

Second reading on the ordinance waiving the requirements for an IGA and expressly consenting to the inclusion of certain property in a joint county industrial park within the Town of Cowpens, South Carolina; and other matters related thereto, was presented to the town council. Pam Camp made a motion to approve the second reading, seconded by Danyelle D. Goode, and carried.

A Hospitality Grant Request was presented to the town council from the Christmas Decorating Committee in the amount of \$2,000.00. Danyelle D. Goode made a motion to approve the request not to exceed \$2,000.00, seconded by Erin P. Wofford, and carried.

Erin P. Wofford made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Pam Camp, and carried.
